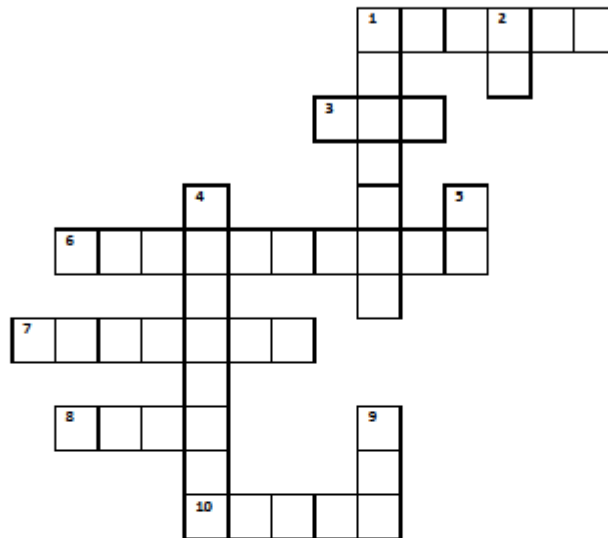

News from International

At the International Board of Directors recent meeting, held this past week, an increase to the quartet registration/renewal fee was approved. **Effective May 1, 2017**, the quartet registration/renewal fee will now be \$100 for registrations received between May 1 and January 15. For registrations received between January 16 and March 31 there will be an additional \$60 processing fee. The last increase in the quartet fees was in May 2008.

The awards for the Sweet Adds Membership Incentive Campaign were refined:

- Add five members – waived international dues for a year, recognition in *The Pitch Pipe*, and a \$5 gift card to International Sales.
- Add 10 members – waived international dues for a year, recognition in *The Pitch Pipe*, and a \$10 gift card to International Sales
- Add 15 members – waived international dues for a year, recognition in *The Pitch Pipe*, and a \$15 gift card to International Sales
- Add 20 members – waived international dues for a year, recognition in *The Pitch Pipe*, and a \$20 gift card to International Sales
- Add 25 members – waived international dues for two years, recognition in *The Pitch Pipe*, acknowledgment on the jumbotron at International Convention, and a \$25 gift card to International Sales

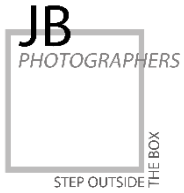
