I would like to explain what we are about to do with the *Harmony Hi-Lo's*, as it seems that not everyone has received this information. If you receive the mailings for your chorus, please make sure that the person who writes for your chorus receives this. Thanks!

First, the *Hi-Lo's* will only be issued **twice a year** – in time for F.L.A.S.H., and in time for Regional Competition. Issues will now be printed in **COLOR**, and must be picked up for your chorus at these two events (you will be picking up copies for your *entire* chorus). Deadlines for each issue will be noted on the Regional Calendar.

For now, if you would like to advertise in the *Hi-Lo's* (remember ... it will be a **COLOR** ad!), we are keeping prices the same: full-page, \$50; half-page, \$25; quarter-page, \$15.

In addition, we will have a "high-five" section, where you can wish your favorite quartet good luck or congratulations, wish your friends a Happy Birthday, thank your director/chorus for a great rehearsal, etc. The cost of these will be \$5 each.

Please remember that this is a work in progress. We welcome your input!

The Region 19 marketing plan for 2014-2015 includes combined internal/external plans along with separate pushes for both.
