Show material can get a quick polish before the show date. And at this time of the year, regional faculty members' coaching calendars are likely to be more open than in the spring.

Please take advantage of your faculty. And please, feel free to contact me. I don't know all of you yet, but I'm eager to meet the members of my new region--and I love to coach.
