Bringing Back "Convention" to Our Regional Contest Weekend:

Thursday Evening Activities:

- Please remember the Joint Briefing (for quartets and choruses) will be held at 7pm Thursday, May 18.
- Immediately following the Briefing there will be a Regional Awards
 Ceremony where Regional leaders will acknowledge those who have
 made great achievements in our region (these have been traditionally
 handed out at the Saturday Night Show of Champions). We are also

- planning some additional new acknowledgements like first timers and longevity awards.
- Following the ceremony, there will be a Social Hour for you to mix and mingle with your regional friends.

• Friday Activities:

- The Education Team is working on some exciting classes for Friday:
 - A 'newbie class' hosted by Sherry Stanton for those new to the regional experience
 - "Putting together an Entertainment Package" with Lustre Quartet.
 - Additionally, we will also have dedicated time to run through the Mass Sing songs before we go out to the square and perform for the public.

Saturday Evening Activities:

- The RCSC is moving the awards from the Saturday Night Show to the Regional Awards Ceremony; thereby, shortening the length of the Show to allow for time for the Regional Afterglow, which will take place immediately following the Show of Champions in the function space outside of the contest venue.
- More information regarding Thursday's Awards Ceremony and the Show will be posted on the regional website once plans are fully solidified.
- This year, choruses may host a hospitality room using the warm up rooms used during the contest (located on the second floor). To reserve a room, contact Sally Kelly, Events Coordinator. Room rental fees will be \$100 for the evening. Once Sally has confirmed that your chorus has a hospitality room reserved, you will then work with the hotel regarding food and beverage options.
